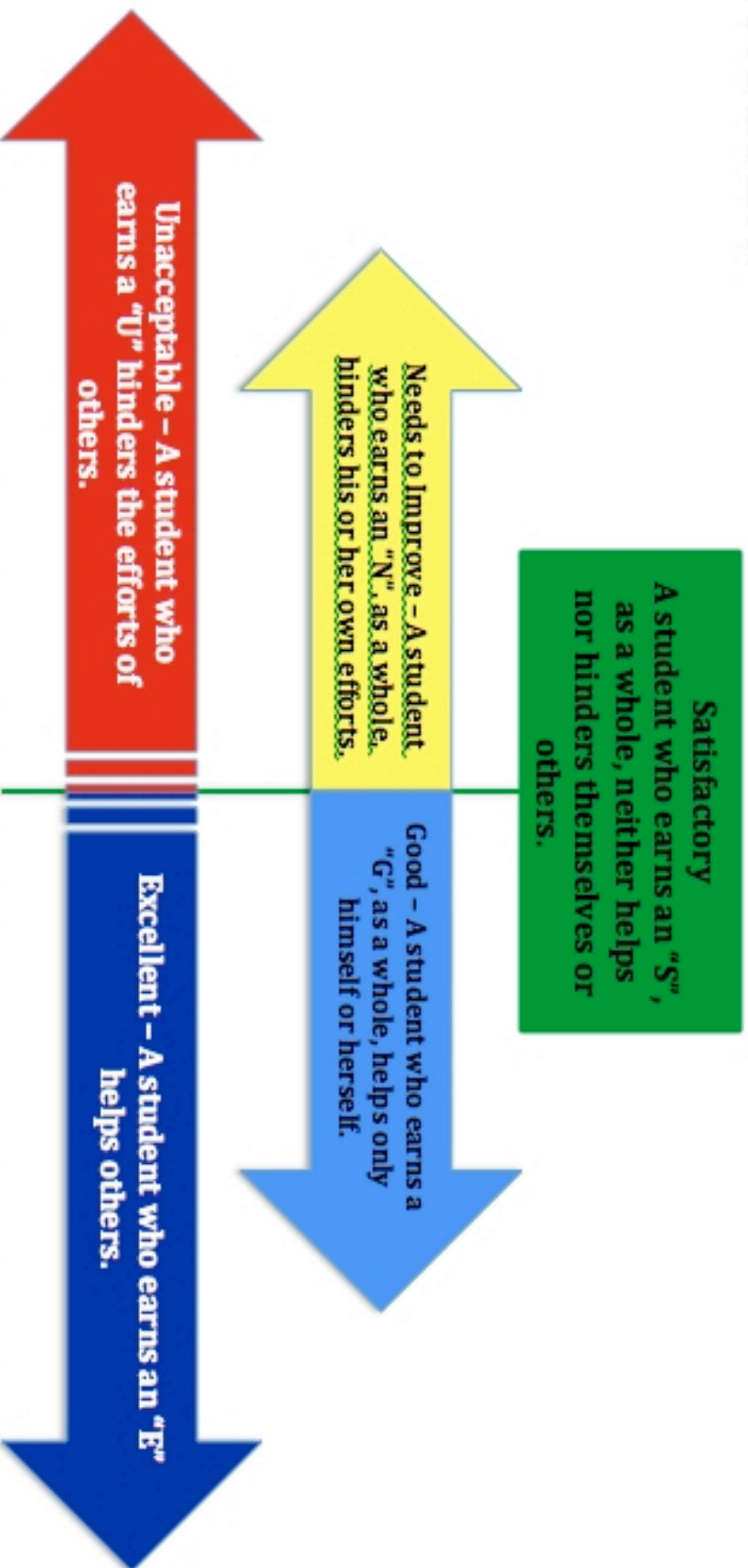

CITIZENSHIP:



Citizenship grades are an evaluation of many factors brought together to measure a student's general behavior and effort in class. It is the culmination of a student's willingness and efforts to help or hinder the progress of class and/or other students. It includes, but is not limited to, following school, classroom, and science safety and dress code rules, being on task and using classwork time wisely, turning their work in ON TIME, showing maturity and responsibility. Citizenship grades are the balance of a student's efforts and behaviors. They are not the result of one day or one action, and, they are not the evaluation of the child as a person.
